| Lycoris radiata-Red Spider Lily | 18" tall, spidery red blooms appear before foliage, Southern Heirloom |
| Lycoris squamigera Pink Surprise Lily | Fall bloomer, large trumpet-shaped flowers, rare, 20" high. |

|------------------------------------------------------|-------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Allium sphaerocephalon | (Drumstick Allium) Ball-shaped flower heads crimson-purple 2-3' stems, flower in May, good cut, dried |
| Gladiola communis 'Byzantine' | Hardy gladiolus w/bright magenta blooms in spring. Circa 1600's |
| Hidden Ginger (Curcuma) | Beautiful pink & white blooms nestled down (hidden) in graceful, layered foliage. |
| Hippeastrum x johnsonii - St. Joseph's Lily | 2' tall w/shiny, strap leaves & fragrant red trumpets. |
| Hyacinthoides hispanica 'Excelsior' Spanish Bluebell | Deep blue, bell-shaped flowers, Shade tolerant |
| Hymenocallis - 'Tropical Giant' | Large, robust plant w/glossy strap-like foliage & white spider-like blooms. |
| Ipheion uniflorum 'Rolf Fiedler' Spring Starflower | Blue, spring blooming flowers w/grass-like foliage. |
| Iris - 'Cemetery White' | Tough, drought tolerant bearded iris, med. height, w/pure white blooms. Texas Heirloom. |
| Leucojum aestivum - Summer Snowflake | 12-18" plant & dainty white, blooms w/green dots on tips. |
| Rhodophiala bifida - Oxblood Lily | Texas heirloom 12"-18" high w/blood red amaryllis-like flowers. Blooms in Sept. |
| Scilla siberica - Squill | Strong color accent in spring. Blue flowers & hardy foliage, best planted closely in drifts. |

| Muscari armeniacum - Grape Hyacinth | Spikes of blue, grape-like, long-lasting blooms in spring, naturalizes, Heirloom |
| Muscari latifolium - Grape Hyacinth | Small, hyacinth-like heads w/light blue upper blooms & deep blue lower blooms |

| Zephyranthes candida - White Rain Lily | White, star-like flowers open after late summer rains. |
| Zephyranthes grandiflora - Pink Rain Lily | Rosy, star-like blooms 3" across, Blooms several times. |
