***Bellis perennis* L.**

English Daisy

- C English Daisies are grown in Texas as a cool season or transition season annual or sometimes as a functional biennial when fall planted for spring bloom; this species is a smaller daisy, often peaking at 60 to 100 tall in our landscapes; suitable for seasonal edging, bedding on tight spacings, or as small pockets of cool season color; the 10 to 20(30) diameter dense composite flowers have white, pink, rose, or red ray flowers with small yellow disk flowers.
- C Full sun to partial shade; some afternoon shade may prolong their useful life into early summer; accepting most any moderate quality garden soils.
